Kos (Greece) 21-21 April 2011

This is a brief report of a rather short April 2011 holiday in the island of Kos (Dodecanese, Greece). I was with my girlfriend, so that it was not a 100% birding holiday, we mostly were around the island, doing also some soft hiking.

This island is interesting because is located near Turkey, it seems to have nice bird species in all seasons (of course in spring too).

Basic facts:

- from 21 April morning until 26 April after noon
- flights with Ryanair from Bergamo Orio al Serio airport
- rented a small car at Hertz in the airport (previously done via Internet)
- stayed at the good Kos Palace Hotel, in Tigkaki. This is a very good choice, because it is in the middle of the island, and near the (maybe) best hot spot, the Alykes Lake. For the hotel, I did a <u>Trip Advisor review</u>, with some photos which are in black and white (my mistake).
- late April is still minus than low (!) season, which means that most of the hotel are closed and many small towns are populated just with locals who are setting up things for the forthcoming summer
- many gas stations and... high priced fuel!

Birdwatching facts:

- Before the holiday, I checked various birding reports and infos, so I did a <u>Kos</u> <u>birding map</u> using (of course) Google Maps. After the holiday I added some improvements. If someone is going in Kos for birding, I really suggest to check it out.
- As I already wrote, it was not a full birding experience. Besides, despite being in late April, migration seemed to be rather late. So, I missed many species which I was almost sure to find in late April, such as Cuckoo, Hoopoe, Roller, Black headed bunting...
- I met no other birder except for Stewart (hi!) who actually lives there, and I met "by chance" at Alykes lake.
- Kos is a 287 km2 island, so is not a very big, it's about 1/5 of Rhodos or Lesvos. In a few days it's possible to reach all the main birding sites. As you can see from the notes in my above mentioned Google map, I actually missed some areas, especially in the east.

Visited areas:

- everyday: Alykes lake, Tigkaki and Marmari area, various sides.
- 22 April: Kos town
- 23 April: Paleo pili (=Old Pili)
- 24 April: from Zia to the top of Mount Dikeos
- 25 April: Weat side (south of Kephalos) and Antimachia fortress
- 26 April: area north of Kardamena and south of Antimachia fortress
