Tunisia: 3 - 10 January 2012

Here is a short report of a birding and nature observation trip, which I did along with 6 other people. The trip took place in some areas of central Tunisia, form 3 to 10 January 2012.

Trip leader was Andrea Corso.

Our flights have been Roma - Tunis (Tunisair) plus Tunis - Djerba (Sevenair), and the opposite way for the return.

We had two "regular" rented cars, not 4x4, and we moved from Djerba and Tozeur, towards the west border. We slept in various places, mainly small nice hotels, in Djerba, Douz, Matmata and so on.

We enjoyed the trip very much, from the birding and naturalistic point of view, but also for the nice people we met, so that we had no trouble in birding and shooting pics everywhere.

We not only saw very interesting birds, but also we found some very nice mammals, invertebrates and reptiles, the latter usually under the stones... anyway the list in here at the bottom. Birding wise, in the inland areas we did not find very great numbers, especially for the desert species. It seems that this winter, or maybe even the previous breeding season, had some unusual features, maybe more rain than the usual, so that birds were more widespread distributed.

Most interesting birds have been:

Marbled Ducks, Ferruginous Ducks, Long-legged Buzzards, Bonelli's Eagles, Lanners, Barbary Partridges, Slender-billed Gulls, Caspian Terns, Laughing Doves, Pharaoh Eagle Owl, Short-eared Owl, Little Swifts, Bar-tailed Larks, Desert Larks, Greater Hoopoe Larks, Thekla Larks, Temminck's Larks, Richard's Pipit, Red-throated Pipits, African Reed Warblers, Tristram's Warblers, Moussier's Redstarts, White-crowned Black Wheatears, Black Wheatears, Maghreb Wheatears, Red-rumped Wheatears, Desert Wheatears, Southern / Desert Grey Shrikes, Brown-necked Ravens, Trumpeter Finches.

- 63. Greater Hoopoe Lark | Alaemon alaudipes | 2-3 in Bir Soltane (in 2 different days); 1 near Beni Keddache

- 69. Common House Martin | Delichon urbica | 1 in Douz
- 70. White Wagtail | Motacilla alba | some seens at various sites
- 71. Richard's Pipit | Anthus richardi | 1 in El Kantara (Djerba)
- 72. Meadow Pipit | Anthus pratensis | some in Djerba and Tojuane
- 73. Red-throated Pipit | Anthus cervinus | some NE of El Kantara (Djerba), near the sea
- 74. Water Pipit | Anthus spinoletta | some in Djerba coasts
- 75. Blue Rock Thrush | Monticola solitarius | 2 in Sidi Bouhlel (Tozeur)
- 76. African Reed Warbler | Acrocephalus baeticatus | various at ponds in Douz and Tozeur
- 77. Common Chiffchaff | Phylloscopus collybita | very common everywhere
- 78. Sardinian Warbler | Sylvia melanocephala | common in various inland sites
- 79. Tristram's Warbler | Sylvia deserticola | 2 in Bir Soltane; 2-3 in Douz
- 80. European Robin | Erithacus rubecula | common in various inland sites
- 81. Black Redstart | Phoenicurus ochruros | some at various sites
- 82. Moussier's Redstart | Phoenicurus moussieri | Single birds in various inland sites
- 83. European Stonechat | Saxicola rubicola | some in palm plantations, wet areas etc.
- 84. White-crowned Black Wheatear | Oenanthe leucopyga | 2-3 in Guermessa; 1 in Sidi Bouhlel (Tozeur)
- 85. Black Wheatear | Oenanthe leucura | various at Matmata and other sites (towns or rocky areas)
- 86. Maghreb Wheatear | Oenanthe halophila | 1 in Bir Soltane; 1 in Guermessa; 1 near Beni Keddache
- 87. Red-rumped Wheatear | *Oenanthe moesta* | 1 at Pipeline road (Matmata Douz); couple at Pipeline road (Douz Bir Soltane); couple near Beni Keddache
- 88. Desert Wheatear | Oenanthe deserti | some in various inland sites (mostly males)
- 89. Southern / Desert Grey Shrike | Lanius meridionalis elegans | common
- 90. Brown-necked Raven | Corvus ruficollis | some at Matmata
- 91. Common Raven | Corvus corax | some both in Djerba and inland areas
- 92. Spotless Starling | Sturnus unicolor | Djerba
- 93. House Bunting | Emberiza striolata | common in towns, at inland sites
- 94. European Greenfinch | Carduelis chloris | group in Tojuane
- 95. European Serin | Serinus serinus | some at Matmata
- 96. Trumpeter Finch | Rhodopechys githaginea | some at Matmata and Sidi Bouhlel (Tozeur)
